Relative to election districts, and for other purposes.

Schuykill oc.
Wayne town-
ship. SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Represent-*
atives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General As-
sembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the
same, That the electors of the township of Wayne, in the
county of Schuykill, shall hereafter hold their general elec-
tions at the house now occupied by Moritz Heilner, innkeep-
er, in the town of Friedensburg, in said township.

Susquehanna
county.
New Milford
township. SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority afore-*
said, That the electors of the township of New Milford, in
Susquehanna county, shall hereafter hold their general elec-
tions at the house now occupied by Harvey Griffin, in said
township.

Erie county.
Girard t'p. SECT. 3. *And be it further enacted by the authority afore-*
said, That Girard township, in the county of Erie, shall
hereafter be a separate election district, and the electors
thereof shall hold their general elections at the School House
near Thomas M'Connell's store, on the east side of Elk
creek.

SECT. 4. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the court of Quarter Sessions of the county of Columbia, shall, at their next term, in addition to those now in office, appoint one supervisor of highways in the township of Mahoning, in said county, who shall reside in the town of Danville, and have and exercise like powers, and perform like duties with those now in office; and the qualified citizens of said township of Mahoning, shall at their next election of constables and other township officers, and annually thereafter, elect three supervisors of highways, one of whom shall reside in the village of Danville, aforesaid, and have and exercise the powers aforesaid.

AN ACT

To annul the marriage contract of Ulrich Knelht and Susannah his wife.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the marriage contract entered into by and between Ulrich Knecht, of Northampton county, and Susannah his wife, be and the same is hereby annulled and made void, and the parties released and discharged from the said contract, and from all duties and obligations arising therefrom, as fully effectually and absolutely as if they had never been joined in marriage.
