AN ACT

Providing for the election of a Senator, to represent this State in the Senate of the United States.

WHEREAS, a vacancy now exists in the representation from this State, in the Senate of the United States: Therefore,

Preamble.

SECTION 1. *It is enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met,* That the members of both houses shall assemble in the chamber of the House of Representatives, at the hour of twelve, on Saturday, the seventh instant, and then and there elect a Senator, to represent this State in the Senate of the United States; and that the candidates be nominated, and the election held and conducted in the manner prescribed by the act entitled, "An act to prescribe the times, places and manner, of choosing Senators to represent this State in the Senate of the United States," passed the fifth day of February, Anno Domini, one thousand eight hundred and two.

Provides for the election of U. S. Senator, on Saturday, 7th Dec.

Election to be held under the provisions of the act of 5th of Feb'y. A. D. 1802.
