AN ACT

Making an appropriation for the repair of the Pennsylvania Canal and Rail-Road.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the sum of one hundred thousand dollars, be, and hereby is appropriated, to the payment of expenses that have been, or may be incurred in the repair of the canals and rail-roads of this Commonwealth; and that the Governor be authorized to draw his warrant on the State Treasurer, in favor of the commissioners of the internal improvement fund, for the said amount, which sum shall be refunded out of any future permanent loan to be hereafter authorized.

\$100,000 appropriated for the repair of canals and rail-roads. Warrant to be drawn for the same by the Governor on the Treas'r. To be refunded out of any permanent loan hereafter authorized.
