AN ACT

For the relief of James Huston and others, soldiers of the revolutionary war.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the State Treasurer be, and he is hereby authorized and required to pay to James Huston, of Washington county, or to his order, forty dollars immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars, payable half yearly, to commence on the first day of January, eighteen hundred and thirty-four.

SECTION 2. The State Treasurer is hereby authorized and required to pay Jacob Gher, of Crawford county, and to Wil. Jacob Gher & William Able, of Montgomery county, or to their respective orders, ^{Gratuities to} forty dollars each, as a gratuity, and in full for their revolutionary services. ^{Wm. Able.}
