AN ACT

Granting aid to Washington College.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the Governor shall, on the first day of May next, draw his warrant on the State Treasurer, in favor of the trustees of Washington College, in Washington county, for the sum of two thousand five hundred dollars, and annually thereafter, on the first day of May, for three years, he shall draw his warrant in favor of said trustees, for the sum of one thousand ^{Grant of} ~~2500.~~ dollars, to be applied to the support of the institution.

AN ACT

For the endowment of La Fayette College at Easton.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the Governor be, and he is hereby authorized and required, at any time between the date of the passage of this act and the first of January next, that may be most convenient to the treasury, to draw his warrant on the State Treasurer in favor of the trustees of La Fayette College, for the sum of four thousand dollars, and annually, for four successive years, to draw his warrant in favor of said trustees, for the sum of two thousand dollars, to commence on the first day of May, eighteen hundred and thirty-five: *Provided,* That no part of the money drawn as above, shall be applied to the payment of teachers. ^{Grant of \$12,000 in 5 instalments.}
