A SUPPLEMENT

To an act entitled "An act authorizing the Governor to incorporate the Philadelphia steam tow-boat Company."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That so much of the eighth section of an act entitled "An act authorizing the Governor to incorporate the Philadelphia Steam tow-boat company," passed the seventh day of April, eighteen hundred and thirty-two, as is included in the first proviso thereof, (excepting so much thereof as requires that an annual statement of the affairs of the said company shall be made to the legislature,) be, and the same is hereby repealed: Provided, That the powers granted by the act to*

A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT
