A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To the "Act to alter the judiciary system of this Commonwealth.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That a writ of error issued from the Supreme Court shall be a supersedeas in all cases, although an execution may have been issued and executed: *Provided,* That said writ of error be issued, served, and bail entered, within three weeks from the day on which judgment shall be entered.
