AN ACT

For the relief of sundry soldiers and widows of soldiers of the revolutionary war.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized and required to pay to Robert McGlaughland, of Adams county, James Wherry, of Washington county, Henry Hess, of Berks county, and Henry Barnhardt, of Montgomery county, or to their respective orders, forty dollars each immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars to each, payable half yearly during life, to commence on the first day of March, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-four.
