AN ACT

For the relief of George Parson, William Zell, Jacob Northeimer, George Goodyear, John Smith, and Michael Robinson, soldiers, Rosanna Lehman and Christiana Keyser, the widows of revolutionary soldiers.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the State Treasurer is hereby authorized and required to pay to George Parson, of Dauphin county, William Zell and Jacob Northeimer, of Lancaster county, George Goodyear, of York county, John Smith and Michael Robinson, of Cumberland county, soldiers of the revolution, or to their respective orders, forty dollars to each immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars to each, during life, payable half yearly, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-four.

SECTION 2. The State Treasurer is hereby authorized and required to pay to Rosanna Lehman and Christiana Keyser, the widows of revolutionary soldiers, of York county, or to their orders, forty dollars to each immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars to each, during life, payable half yearly, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-four.
