## AN ACT

To extend the time for completing certain Turnpike Roads.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the commissioners named in the Carbondale and Tunkhannock, Sugar Loaf and Hale's Eddy, and Carbondale and Lackawanna turnpike road companies in the acts passed the eighth and ninth days of April, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-three, be authorized to open the books to receive subscriptions to the stock of said companies, at any time previous to the first day of November next.

SECTION 2. The time for completing the turnpike road from the intersection of the Bristol and Newtown roads, at the rocks in Oxford, through Bustleton and Smithfield, in the county of Philadelphia, to the Buck tavern in Southampton, in the county of Bucks, be and is hereby extended for ten years from and after the passing of this act, reserving to the company all the privileges, liberties and franchises, and all their rights and powers for carrying on and completing the said road within the time so extended, in as complete a manner as they have heretofore enjoyed them.
