AN ACT

For the endowment of the West Chester Academy, in the county of Chester.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the Governor be and he is hereby authorized and required, immediately after the passage of this act, to draw his warrant on the State Treasurer in favour of the trustees of the West Chester Academy, for the sum of one thousand dollars, and annually for three successive years, to draw his warrant in favour of said trustees, for the sum of five hundred dollars, to commence on the first day of May, eighteen hundred and thirty-five.
