AN ACT

To revive and continue its force an act entitled "An act to enable the Governor to incorporate a company for making an artificial road from the Springhouse tavern, in Montgomery county, and thence to the borough of Northampton, in the county of Lehigh, and the town Bethlehem, in the county of Northampton, approved the sixteenth day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirteen, and the several supplements thereto, and a further supplement to the said act.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That an act entitled An act to enable the Governor to incorporate a company for making an artificial road from the Springhouse tavern, in Montgomery county, and thence to the borough of Northampton, in the county of Lehigh, and to the town of Bethlehem, in the county of Northampton, approved the sixteenth day of January, eighteen hundred and thirteen; that the several supplements to said act, except so much of the same as may be inconsistent with the provisions of this act, be and the same are hereby revived and declared to be and remain in full force and virtue, and to be, to all intents and purposes, as good and valid as if the same were at large re-enacted.

SECTION 2. That the said company be and they are hereby allowed ten years, from and after the passage of this act, to make and complete the said road, in the manner directed and provided for in and by the act to which this is a further supplement.
