AN ACT

For the relief of James M'Cord, James Glasgow, Samuel Campbell, George Gruber, Samuel Shaw, John Ditlow, Joseph Hogeland, Henry Bloss, Henry Ream, Job Helms, Robert Dunn, George Hiebner, and John Muffley, soldiers, and Agnes Bannon, the widow of a revolutionary soldier.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the State Treasurer is hereby authorized and required to pay to James M'Cord, James Glasgow and Samuel Campbell, of Mifflin county, George Gruber and Samuel Shaw, of Delaware county, John Ditlow and Joseph Hogeland, of Bucks county, Henry Bloss of Northampton county, and Henry Ream, of Lancaster county, soldiers of the revolution, or to their respective orders, forty dollars to each immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars to each during life, payable half yearly, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-four.

SECTION 2. The State Treasurer is hereby authorized and required to pay to Agnes Bannon, of Beaver county, the widow of a revolutionary soldier, or to her order, forty dollars immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars during life, payable half yearly, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-four.

SECTION 3. The State Treasurer is hereby authorized and required to pay to Job Helms, of Delaware county, Robert Dunn, of Franklin county, George Hiebner, of Schuylkill county, and John Muffley, of Northampton county, soldiers, or their respective orders, a gratuity of forty dollars to each immediately, for their revolutionary services.
