A SUPPLEMENT

To an act entitled "An act incorporating the towns of Lawrenceville and Covington in Tioga county."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That it shall be lawful for all persons entitled to vote for members of Assembly, and who have resided in the borough of Covington thirty days previous to any election for borough officers, to vote at such election, although they shall not have previously paid a borough tax.

SECTION 2. From and after the passage of this act, the said borough elections shall be held on the second Monday of April, in each and every year,

SECTION 3. On the second Monday of April next, after the passage of this act, the inhabitants of said borough entitled to vote as aforesaid, shall elect one member of council to serve for three years, and that annually thereafter one member of council shall be elected, to serve for three years.

SECTION 4. All by-laws and ordinances passed by the burgess and council of the borough of Covington who were elected on the second Monday of April eighteen hundred and thirty-two, instead of the fourth Monday of May, be and the same are hereby declared to be valid and effectual, to all intents and purposes, as if the said council and burgess had been elected on said fourth Monday of May, and so much of the act to which this is a supplement, as is hereby altered or supplied, be and the same is hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. It shall be lawful for all persons entitled to vote for members of Assembly, and who have resided in the borough of Wellsborough, in Tioga county, thirty days previous to any election for borough officers, to vote at such elections, although they shall not have paid a borough tax.
