AN ACT

For the relief of the Saint John's Orphan Asylum, in the city of Philadelphia

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same*, That the house in Chesnut street, in the city of Philadelphia, called "the Gothic Mansion," and now owned and occupied by an institution called "the Saint John's Orphan Asylum," together with the lot of ground whereon the same is erected, be and the same is hereby exempted from taxation, so long as it shall continue to be the property of that charitable institution, and used for an asylum, as aforesaid, and no longer.
