AN ACT

For the relief of sundry soldiers and widows of soldiers of the revolutionary war.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the State Treasurer is hereby authorized and required to pay to Samuel Auchmuty of Dauphin county, Andrew Huber of Lebanon county, Charles M'Lenaghan of Mifflin county, Adam Thomas, Alexander Clarke of Adams county, John Welsh and Conrad Kline of York county, soldiers of the revolutionary war, or to their respective orders, forty dollars to each immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars to each during life, payable half yearly, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-four.

SECTION 2. The State Treasurer is hereby authorized and required to pay to Eleanor Harris of Cumberland county, Elizabeth Stillwagon of Fayette county, Catharine Kitts of Delaware county, Susanna Peters of Montgomery county, Susanna Stokely of Westmoreland county, Barbara Margareta Reese of Berks county, Mary Kreidler and Dorothy Hileman of York county, the widows of revolutionary soldiers, or to their respective orders, forty dollars to each immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars to each during life, payable half yearly; to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-four.

SECTION 3. The State Treasurer is hereby authorized and required to pay to John Keims of Adams county, Daniel Youndt of Armstrong county, and Nicholas James of York county, soldiers, and Mary Eve Seider of Berks county, the widow of a revolutionary soldier, a gratuity of forty dollars to each immediately.
