AN ACT

To transfer certain State stock,

Stock trans-
ferred by
commonw'th
to company.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That so much of the stock of the Commonwealth in the bridge over the north east branch of the river Susquehanna, at the town of Catawissa, in the county of Columbia, as may be necessary to construct a wagon road on the berm bank of sections eighty-eight and eighty-nine of the North Branch division of the Pennsylvania canal, be and the same is hereby transferred at par value, to the president, managers and company, for erecting said bridge, with power to sell the same, the proceeds thereof to be applied by them to the purpose aforesaid.

SECTION 2. It shall be the duty of the said president, managers and company, to keep a fair and correct account of the moneys necessarily expended in the construction of said road, and upon the completion of the same make report thereof to the Auditor General, who is hereby authorized to examine and settle said accounts, and report the same, or a copy thereof, to the Legislature, as soon thereafter as conveniently may be.
