

ation of the said regiment as the field officers of the same shall adjudge and determine, and the said officers are authorized to substitute battalion or company musters for inspection, instead of regimental musters and parades, and for that purpose they shall have power to fix the places for such musters, within the said regiment, having a regard to the most central and convenient places. And when any vacancy shall occur among the field officers of said regiment, an election shall be held to fill the same by each battalion, and the person having the highest number of votes given, in such regiment so voting in battalions, shall be elected.

SECTION 5. The Adjutant General is hereby authorized to issue swords, pistols and accoutrements, to the "Union Troops of Cavalry of Perry county," in case such swords, pistols and accoutrements shall remain, after supplying such corps as are now by law authorized to receive them by this act: *Provided*, That security shall be given to return the same, whenever they may be required to supply corps in other brigades, which have not now the number of such corps to which each brigade is by law entitled: *And provided also*, That all other security and conditions shall be given and observed, as are now by law required.

A SUPPLEMENT

To the act entitled, "An act to incorporate the York and Maryland line rail road company."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same*, That the amount required to be paid to the commissioners by persons offering to subscribe for stock under the provisions of the first section of the original act, to which this is a supplement, be reduced from five dollars to one dollar on each share of said subscribed stock, and that the term managers and directors indiscriminately used in the said act be

taken and understood to mean the same thing and to express the same description of officers thereby created.

Rates of toll. SECTION 2. The rates of charge referred to in the twentieth section of said act, are hereby fixed specifically as follows, viz: Not exceeding two cents per ton per mile for tolls, and three cents per ton per mile for transportation, and not exceeding three cents per mile for each passenger, and the tolls on said road shall at no time be reduced lower than the rates charged on the Philadelphia and Columbia rail road.

Commiss'rs to give 4 weeks previous notice. SECTION 3. The commissioners named in the act to which this is a supplement, or a majority of them shall as soon as conveniently may be after the letters patent shall be obtained, give at least four weeks previous notice in the newspapers therein named, of the time and place by them appointed within this commonwealth, to organize the said company and to choose by a majority of votes of the said subscribers by ballot, to be given in person or by proxy, which proxy shall have been obtained and bear date within three months next preceding the election at which such proxy duly authorized, shall be presented, twelve directors from among the stockholders, a majority of whom shall elect a president from among the said board or stockholders, and such other officers as shall be deemed necessary, and supply vacancies which may occur, by death, resignation, or otherwise, the board thus chosen shall conduct the business of said company until the third Monday of October thence next ensuing, or until their successors be duly chosen, at which time the annual election shall take place within this Commonwealth, notice thereof having been given as is required to be given in the act to which this is a supplement, to be conducted as is directed in and by the said act, and make such by-laws, orders and regulations for the government of said company, as are not inconsistent with the constitution and laws of the United States, or of this State, and that may be necessary for the well governing the affairs of the company: *Provided*, That in locating said road as directed by the twelfth section, the place of beginning shall be at the north line of the borough of York, east of Beaver street.

Repeal. SECTION 4. The third section and such other parts of the original act to which this is a supplement, as are hereby altered or supplied, are hereby repealed.
