A SUPPLEMENT

To the act entitled, "A further supplement to an act to incorporate a company to make an artificial road by the best and nearest route from Waterford in the county of Erie, through Meadville and Franklin, to the river Susquehanna at or near the mouth of Anderson's creek in Clearfield county, and also to incorporate a company for making an artificial road from the town of Northumberland, in the county of Northumberland, by the best and nearest route to the West Branch of the Susquehanna river at or near the mouth of Anderson's creek, passing through Derrstown, Youngmanstown, Aaronsburg, Bellefonte, and Milledaleburg."

WHEREAS under the act passed the eighth day of April one thousand eight hundred and thirty-three, making the bridge over the West Branch of the Susquehanna river in the county of Clearfield, a toll bridge where the Philipsburg and Susquehanna turnpike crosses the same in the county of Clearfield no provision is made for punishing offences against the said act.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That if any toll gatherer shall demand or receive any other or greater rates or prices for passing over the said bridge than are specified by law, the person so offending shall for every such offence pay the sum of five dollars to be paid to the party aggrieved, and recovered as debts of equal amount are by law recoverable, and every person owning, riding in, or driving any carriage of burden or pleasure, or owning, riding, leading or driving any horse or mule, or driving any hogs, sheep or cattle, or passing on foot, shall evade the payment of any of the tolls by force or otherwise, after passing over the said bridge, every person or persons so offending shall forfeit and pay a sum not exceeding five dollars, to be sued for and recovered in the name of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, before any justice of the peace of the county of Clearfield with costs of suit as debts of equal amount are by law recoverable.
