AN ACT

For the relief of William Adams and others of the Revolutionary War.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized and required to pay to David Frazier, Esq., of Washington county, or to his order, for the use and benefit of William Adams, of Greene county, a soldier of the revolutionary war, forty dollars immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars during the life of the said William Adams, payable half yearly, to commence on the first day of March, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-four.

SECTION 2. The State Treasurer is authorized and required to pay to Jacob Brower and Matthew Skipton, of Mifflin county, soldiers, and Mary Reed of Adams county, the widow of a revolutionary soldier, or to their respective orders a gratuity of forty dollars to each immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars during life payable half yearly, to commence on the first day of March, eighteen hundred and thirty-four.
