A SUPPLEMENT

To an act passed March twenty-ninth one thousand eight hundred and twenty-seven, "An act to incorporate and endow the academy of the Protestant Episcopal Church in the city of Philadelphia."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That so much of the fundamental laws of the corporation created by the act to which this is a supplement, and which were recognized and adopted by the said act as requires the payment of ten pounds to entitle a certain description of persons to be elected trustees, be and the same is hereby repealed and that from and after the passage of this act, the four persons annually to be elected trustees, as well as those who shall be chosen to supply vacancies occasioned by death, removal or resignation, may and shall be elected by the remaining trustees from among clergymen of the Protestant Episcopal church, resident in the city of Philadelphia, or within five miles thereof, or from persons qualified to be elected vestrymen of any church in the said communion in the said city or within the said distance therefrom. SECTION 2. It shall and may be lawful for the said corporation to employ their general funds or any part thereof for the support of the free school or for any of the other objects prescribed or recognized either by the said fundamental laws or by the said act to which this is a supplement, but not to employ any part of the funds expressly given for the free school to any object unconnected therewith. Funds may be applied to support of free schools.

SECTION 3. Five of the said incorporated trustees duly convened, shall be a quorum for the transaction of ordinary business and for ordering the payment of the current expenses of the corporation but for the purposes of authorizing the conveyance of real estate or of making by-laws, a majority of the whole number shall be present in order to constitute a quorum. 5 a quorum.

SECTION 4. This act shall within sixty days after its passage be laid before a meeting of the contributors to the said Academy duly convened by public notice in at least two of the daily newspapers of the city of Philadelphia, and if approved of by them shall become part of the charter of the said corporation. This act to be laid before contributors for approval.
