A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To the act entitled "An act to erect the town of Milton in the county of Northumberland, and the town of Butler in the county of Butler, in boroughs," passed the twenty-sixth day of February, one thousand eight hundred and seventeen, and for other purposes.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the borough of Butler shall be a separate election district, and that the inhabitants of said borough entitled to vote by the act to which this is a supplement, shall have power to elect overseers of the poor and assessors of said borough, in the manner and at the time affixed by law for electing township officers, who shall have the same power and be subjected to same penalties which overseers of the poor and assessors have and are subjected to by law; and the said inhabitants of said borough shall also on the fourth Monday of May next, and on the Friday preceding the third Saturday in March, every year thereafter, have the power to elect four persons for the office of constable, and shall return the names of the persons so elected to the next court of General Quarter Sessions of the Peace to be holden for said county, and the court shall appoint two of them constables for said borough, in the same manner as other township constables are appointed, which constables when so appointed by the court, shall have the same power, be subject to all the penalties which constables have and are subjected to by law; all of whom shall be citizens residing in said borough.

SECTION 2. In all elections hereafter to be held in said borough, previous to the opening of such election, such of the citizens as are present shall elect one reputable citizen as judge of

said election, instead of three, as provided by the act incorporating the said borough, and the said judge shall perform the duties enjoined by said law on the three judges by it authorized to be elected, and so much of said act as is hereby altered or supplied, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Simon Cameron, George Mish, Walter C. Livingston and Doctor J. Green, are hereby appointed commissioners to do and perform the several things contained in the acts incorporating the Rock Cabin and Tangascootack Rail Road Company; and shall have authority to open books for receiving subscriptions of the stock of said company, at such time and place as they may judge suitable and expedient.

AN ACT

To authorize the Canal Commissioners to make a re estimate of the work done by Jonathan Leslie, in constructing the Aqueduct at Shaffer's Ford, Huntingdon county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the canal commissioners be, and they are hereby directed to appoint three competent engineers, who or a majority of them shall proceed to estimate the work done by Jonathan Leslie, in constructing the aqueduct over the Juniata river, at Shaffer's ford, and the work done by Bishop and M'Coy, in constructing an aqueduct over the Juniata river at Jack's narrows, agreeably to the prices which were to be allowed according to the agreement, between the principal engineer and acting canal commissioners, with the said Jonathan Leslie, and Bishop and M'Coy. The report to be made to the canal commissioners, and the balance due if any, to be paid in the usual manner.
