**No. 2.****RESOLUTION**

Appointing a Commissioner to take charge of the Public property at Erie and Waterford.

Preamble.

WHEREAS, By an act of Assembly, entitled "An act appointing commissioners for the purpose of taking care of the public property at Erie and Waterford, and for other purposes," passed the twentieth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and twelve, Thomas Wilson, John Boyd and John Lytle were appointed commissioners to take charge of certain lands specified in said act: *And whereas*, Thomas Wilson and John Lytle,

two of the said commissioners, died some years since, and the survivor, John Boyd, has declined acting: Therefore,

*Resolved, by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met,* That Rufus S. Reed, of the borough of Erie, be and he is hereby appointed commissioner to take charge of the land, with its appurtenances, specified in said act, and to do and perform all acts and things required to be done and performed by Thomas Wilson, John Boyd and John Lytle in said act, as fully and effectually as the said Wilson, Boyd and Lytle were empowered to do and act.
