An Act

To alter the charters of the boroughs of Liverpool, Gettysburg and Hanover.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the borough of Liverpool and the township of Liverpool, in the county of Perry, are hereby declared to be separated, and hereafter shall act as distinct communities in reference to county rates and levies, the school laws, and to all intents and purposes as any two townships are separate, any thing in the act entitled "An act to incorporate the town of Liverpool in the county of Perry, into a borough," to the contrary notwithstanding.

Borough and township of Liverpool, in Perry co. separat'd into two districts.

SECTION 2. The election now authorized to be held on the first Tuesday of April, for borough officers in the borough of Hanover, in the county of York, shall hereafter be held on the third Friday of March in each and every year, and so much of the act incorporating the borough of Hanover, as is hereby altered and supplied, is hereby repealed.

Borough of Hanover, in county of York, elect'n altered.

SECTION 3. From and after the passage of this act, the road tax for the borough of Gettysburg, shall be expended under the direction of the town council of said borough; and the borough election directed to be held on the third Friday of March, by the second section of this act, for the borough of Hanover, shall be held the present year on Friday the third day of April, eighteen hundred and thirty-five.
