An Act

To authorize the trustees of the Methodist Episcopal church in Carlisle, Cumberland county, to sell and convey certain real estate.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That Hugh Reed, John Phillips, Abel Keeney, Isaac Bell, David Reisinger, Michael Dipple, Theodore Myers, Charles Bell, trustees of the Methodist Episcopal church in Carlisle, Cumberland county, are hereby authorized and empowered to sell and convey in fee simple, all the estate, right, title and interest of the said trustees and of the members of the said church, of, in and to the lot and church building erected thereon, of the said trustees and members, situate in the borough of Carlisle, Cumberland county, on Church alley, and numbered ninety-nine in the general plan of the said borough.

An Act

To change a part of the line between the counties of Franklin and Cumberland, to establish the division line between the counties of Huntingdon and Mifflin, and relative to the line between Perry and Juniata.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That from and after the passage of this act, the line dividing the county of Franklin from the county of Cumberland, shall be altered as follows, viz: Beginning on the public road leading from Strasburg to Shippensburg, at the point where said road crosses said line; thence by the middle of said road to its junction with the turnpike road in the borough of Shippensburg;
