An Act

To authorize the increase of the annual income of the Roman Catholic Society of Saint Joseph, for educating and maintaining poor orphan children.

Proviso.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the Roman Catholic Society of Saint Joseph for educating and maintaining poor orphan children, shall have power to increase the clear yearly value or income of the messuages, houses, lands and tenements, rents, annuities or other hereditaments and real estate of the corporation, to an amount not exceeding eight thousand dollars: *Provided,* That the same shall be applied to the erection of suitable buildings, and to the education, comfort and maintenance of poor orphan children, and for no other purpose whatsoever; and that a separate and distinct account of such application shall be kept by said society.

SECTION 2. That if the said society shall at any time misapply the said funds, or in any other respect abuse the trust confided to them, it shall be in the power of the legislature at any time to modify or repeal this act.

An Act

Authorizing the election of assessor and assistant assessors in the borough of Tamaqua, in the county of Schuylkill, and to erect said borough into a separate election district.
