An Act

To authorize Joseph Engle and Archibald T. Dick to sell and convey certain real estate held by them in trust.

WHEREAS by deed bearing date the twenty-fourth day of May, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty, and recorded in the office for recording deeds for the city and county of Philadelphia in deed book G. W. R. No. thirty-six, page five hundred and forty-four, Zedekiah W. Flower and Mary B. his wife, conveyed to Joseph Engle and Archibald T. Dick, certain real estate therein described, lying in the township of Moyamensing, in the county of Philadelphia, in trust for the uses, intents and purposes which follow, viz: that they the said trustees should sell a part of the said real estate for the purpose of raising a specified sum to be paid to the said Zedekiah W. Flower, and that the residue or remainder of the said real estate should be to the sole and separate use of the said Mary B. Flower during her life, and after the death of the said Mary B. to the use and benefit of the children of the said Zedekiah W. and Mary B. who might be living, their heirs and assigns forever: *And whereas*, the said Mary B. Flower, died about two years since, leaving to survive her issue six children, viz: Thomas, John, Richard, Hannah, Archibald and Mary, all of whom except Thomas, are in their minority: *And whereas*, the said trustees have represented to the Legislature that the said residue of the said real estate is unproductive and burdensome by reason of taxes and other charges, and that the said minors would be benefited by a sale of their interests in the same: Therefore,

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That Joseph Engle and Archibald T. Dick be and they are hereby authorized to sell the interests of John, Richard, Z. W. Flower Trustees authorized to sell interests of minor children of

Hannah, Archibald and Mary, minor children of Zedekiah W. Flower and Mary B. his wife in certain real estate lying and being in the township of Moyamensing, in the county of Philadelphia, and held in trust by them for the use of the said minors, and to convey and release in fee simple, all or any part of the right, title and interest of the said minors in the said real estate, and to execute the necessary conveyances for the transfer of or releasing the same to the purchasers which shall have the same legal force and effect, as if the said minors were of full age and had done the same: *Provided*, That before execution of the said deed, deeds or releases, the said trustees shall severally enter into bonds with such security as shall be approved by the Orphans' Court of Philadelphia county, and there filed on record, conditioned for the faithful execution of the trust hereby committed to them, and for the application of the proceeds of the said sale to the use and benefit of the said minors respectively.

A Supplement

To an act entitled "An act to authorize the trustees of Athens township, in Bradford county, to convey certain lands," passed the twenty seventh day of March, Anno Domini, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-seven.

fill vacancies.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same*, That the taxable inhabitants of the present borough and township of Athens, in Bradford county, who are qualified to vote at the general election for members of assembly shall be authorized to elect a trustee for the inhabitants of said borough and township, to supply the vacancy occasioned by the decease of John Franklin, late one of the said trustees, and to supply any vacancy that may hereafter occur in the board of trustees, which election shall be notified and conducted as hereinafter directed.

SECTION 2. The meeting for electing the said trustee or trustees shall be held at the academy in the borough of Athens,
