An Act

Making an appropriation to the Eastern and Western Penitentiaries.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the sum of fourteen thousand four hundred and forty dollars, be and the same is hereby appropriated for the completion of the Western Penitentiary and the construction of a culvert from the same to the Allegheny river, to be paid out of any unappropriated moneys in the treasury : *Provided,* That the bricks belonging to the Commonwealth shall be used in laying said culvert. 14,440

SECTION 2. The sum of sixty thousand dollars is hereby appropriated for the completion of the Eastern Penitentiary, and for paving the street in front of the same, to be paid out of any unappropriated moneys in the Treasury, from time to time, as the state of the works may require. \$60,000
