**Supplement**

To the act entitled An act to incorporate the trustees of the township and borough of Wilkesbarre, the trustees of the township of Plymouth, and the trustees of the township of Hanover, in the county of Luzerne, passed second April, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-one, and for other purposes.

- SECTION 1.** *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the provisions of the act to which this is a supplement be and the same are hereby extended to the township and the proprietors of the township of Providence, one of the seventeen certified townships in the county aforesaid, and that until the annual election provided for in said act, John J. Dings, Samuel De Puy, junior, William Merryfield, Joshua Griffin, junior, Nathaniel Colthill, junior, shall be vested with the powers of trustees under this act: *Provided,* All the taxable inhabitants of the said township of Providence shall be entitled to vote at the annual election for officers: *Provided,* That no sale heretofore made shall be affected by this act.
- SECTION 2.** From and after the passage of this act, the township of Adams, in the county of Lycoming, shall be known and called by the name of Limestone township.
- SECTION 3.** That the Southwark rail-road company be authorized to construct and own steam boats for the purposes of transportation on the river Delaware, between said rail-road and the Camden and Amboy rail-road.
