**An Act**

For the relief of Adam Mengel, and Jacob Wertman and John Adam Gentsel, revolutionary soldiers.

**SECTION 1.** *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the State Treasurer is hereby authorized and required to pay to Adam Mengel of Schuylkill county, soldier, or to his respective order, forty dollars immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars during his life, payable half yearly, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-six.

**SECTION 2.** The State Treasurer is authorized and required to pay to Jacob Wertman of Schuylkill county, and John Adam Gentsel of Columbia county, a gratuity of forty dollars each, immediately, in full for their revolutionary services; the foregoing gratuities and pensions to be paid in conformity to the existing laws.
