An Act

For the relief of sundry soldiers and widows of soldiers of the revolutionary war.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the State Treasurer is hereby authorized and

required to pay to John Kinter, senior, of Indiana county, Annuities & Samuel Barr and James Linn of Washington county, Henry gratuities of Frankfort of Dauphin county, and Henry Cook of Lebanon 40 dollars, to county, soldiers of the revolutionary war, and Jane White of J. Kinter and Westmoreland county, the widow of a soldier of the revolution others
 ary war, or to their respective orders, forty dollars each, immediately, as a gratuity, and an annuity of forty dollars each during life, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-six.

SECTION 2. The State Treasurer is authorized and required to pay to Kilián Briney of Westmoreland county, a gratuity of forty dollars, in full for his revolutionary services; K. Briney. Gratiuity of 40 dollars to the foregoing gratuities and pensions to be paid in conformity with existing laws.
