**An Act**

Making appropriations for the repairs of Canals and Railroads, and for paying the cost of motive power.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the sum of seventy thousand dollars be, and the same is hereby appropriated to defray the cost of repairs already made, or necessary hereafter to be made, on the finished lines of canal and railroad, in order to prepare said works for the business of the coming spring, and for rebuilding the lock at Greensburg, on the Eastern division of the Pennsylvania canal; and that the further sum of forty thousand dollars be appropriated towards the expense heretofore incurred, or which may hereafter be required, to maintain the motive power on the Columbia and Portage railroads, and that the said several sums of money be paid out of any moneys now in the Treasury.
