An Act

For the relief of William Ruff, late a Commissioner of the county of Philadelphia.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the commissioners of the county of Philadelphia be, and they are hereby empowered to draw their warrant on the treasurer of said county, in favor of William Ruff, late a commissioner of said county, for the amount of his daily pay from the nineteenth of October, eighteen hundred and thirty-five, to the thirty-first of December of the same year.

An Act

For the relief of Peter Hammer and others, soldiers and widows of soldiers of the revolutionary war.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the State Treasurer is hereby authorized and required to pay to Peter Hammer of Fayette county, John Foust of Columbia county, Mary Brookhouser of Crawford county, Elizabeth Ludwick of Philadelphia county, soldiers and widows of soldiers of the revolutionary war, or to their respective orders, forty dollars to each immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars to each during life, payable half yearly, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-seven.
