An Act

For the relief of the heirs of John M'Daniel, deceased.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the State Treasurer be, and he is hereby authorized and required to pay to the heirs of John M'Daniel, late of Warren county, in the state of Ohio, deceased, or to their order or orders, two hundred dollars, in full for a certain tract of donation land, situate in the tenth district of donation lands, and numbered two thousand one hundred and forty-two, containing two hundred acres, and allowance, of six per cent. for roads, which was granted to Patrick Murray, in consideration of the services rendered by him in the army of the United States, and whose right and interest became legally vested in the said John M'Daniel, deceased, and which said tract of land fell within the state of New York, upon the line being run between that state and the state of Pennsylvania: *Provided,* That the said heirs of said John M'Daniel, deceased, shall first deposit in the Land Office their title papers, and a release thereof.
