An Act

To increase the Contingent Fund of the Land office, and Auditor General's office, and the office of the State Treasurer.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars be appropriated to the contingent fund of the Land office, two hundred and fifty dollars to the contingent fund of the Auditor General's office, and one hundred dollars to the Treasurer's office, in addition to the present amount thereof, and that the same be annually paid out of any unappropriated money in the treasury.

SECTION 2. That the sum of five hundred dollars be appropriated from any moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, to pay the amount of deficiency in said fund at the Land office, if the same be required, to be accounted for as provided for by law.
