An Act

For the relief Conrad Hurtz, and other soldiers and widows of soldiers of the Revolutionary and Indian wars.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the State Treasurer be, and he is hereby authorized to pay to Conrad Hurtz of Berks county, Martin Wise and David Thomas of Delaware county, Jacob Grosrad of Beaver county, Jacob Kline of Mifflin county, Martin Cronemiller of Union county, Isaac Miller of Erie county, Michael Gumpf of Lancaster county, Martin Freas of Montgomery county, and Hannah M'Kim of Beaver county, soldiers and a widow of a soldier of the revolutionary war, or to their respective orders, forty dollars each immediately, as a gratuity, and an annuity of forty dollars each during life, to be paid half yearly, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-seven. Annuity and gratuity of \$40 to Conrad Hurtz and others, soldiers, &c.

SECTION 2. That the State Treasurer is hereby authorized and required to pay to John Knight of Beaver county; a gratuity of forty dollars immediately, in full for the service performed by him in the revolutionary war. Gratuity of \$40 to John Knight.

SECTION 3. That the State Treasurer is hereby authorized and required to pay to John Hawk of Armstrong county, Joseph Lereno and Robert Ewing of Westmoreland county, Samuel Lord, Richard Vansickle and Henry Manly of Crawford county, soldiers of the Indian war, or to their respective orders, forty dollars each immediately, as a gratuity, and an annuity of forty dollars each during life, to be paid half yearly, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-seven. Annuity and gratuity of \$40 to John Hawk and others, soldiers, &c.

SECTION 4. That the State Treasurer is hereby authorized and required to pay to William White of Indiana county, a gratuity of forty dollars immediately, in full for the service performed by him in the Indian war. Gratuity of \$40 to Wm. White.

SECTION 5. The State Treasurer be, and he is hereby authorized and required to pay to Thomas Shaffer of Washington county, John Lose of Northampton county, George Rumpfield of Lehigh county, Sarah Nickleson of Juniata county, John Smith of Baltimore, (to be paid by the treasurer of York county,) Ann McDowell of Chester county, Henry Gordan and Jonathan Harlin of Mercer county, James Watt and William Taylor of Centre county, and Adam Lockabaugh of Franklin county, soldiers and widow Annuity and gratuity of \$40 to Thos. Shaffer and others, soldiers, &c.

of a soldier of the revolutionary war, or their respective orders, forty dollars each immediately, as a gratuity, and an annuity of forty dollars each during life, to be paid half yearly, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven.

Annuity and gratuity of \$40 to H^y. Shaffer and others, soldiers, &c.

SECTION 6 That the State Treasurer be, and he is hereby authorized and required to pay to Henry Shaffer and Sarah Ash of Allegheny county, and Church Smith of Armstrong county, soldiers and widow of a soldier of the Indian war, or their respective orders, forty dollars each immediately, as a gratuity, and an annuity of forty dollars each, to be paid half yearly, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven.

Annuity and gratuity of \$40 to John Bell and others, soldiers, &c.

SECTION 7. The State Treasurer is hereby authorized and required to pay to John Bell of Juniata county, John Hantz of Dauphin county, Andrew Dennis of Allegheny county, soldiers, and Sophia Benedict of Lancaster county, a widow of a soldier of the Revolutionary war, or to their respective orders, forty dollars to each immediately, as a gratuity, and an annuity of forty dollars to each during life, payable half yearly, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven.

Annuity and gratuity of \$40 to J. F. Randolph, and others, soldiers, &c.

SECTION 8. The State Treasurer is hereby authorized and required to pay to James F. Randolph and William Gill of Crawford county, Jacob Willard and Daniel Davies of Armstrong county, Robert Hunter of Westmoreland county, soldiers of the Indian war, or to their respective orders, forty dollars to each immediately, as a gratuity, and an annuity of forty dollars to each during life, payable half yearly, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven.

Gratuity of \$40 to Wm. Shannon.

SECTION 9. The State Treasurer is hereby authorized and required to pay to William Shannon of Crawford county, a gratuity of forty dollars immediately, in full for the service performed by him in the Indian war.

Gratuity of \$40 to Alex^r Lowry.

SECTION 10. The State Treasurer is hereby authorized and required to pay to Alexander Lowry of Armstrong county, a gratuity of forty dollars immediately, in full for the service performed by him in the revolutionary war. The foregoing pensions and gratuities to be paid in conformity with the existing laws.
