An Act

For the relief of the Volunteer Troop styled "Green Cavalry," of Greene county, Pennsylvania, and for other purposes.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That it shall be the duty of the Adjutant General to furnish, upon the order of the Brigade Inspector of the second brigade, fourteenth division, of Pennsylvania militia, out of any of the arsenals of this commonwealth, when a sufficient number of unappropriated arms and accoutrements may be had, eighty stand of cavalry arms, for the use of a volunteer troop of cavalry attached to said brigade, styled the "Green Cavalry," to be issued by said Brigade Inspector to the commissioned officers, for the use of the members thereof: *Provided,* Such cavalry arms shall be issued under such restrictions, provisions, and security, as are now by law required. Green Cavalry to have arms. Proviso.

SECTION 2. That from and after the passage of this act, every citizen of this commonwealth, and subject to the performance of militia duty, residing within the bounds of the second military division, composed of the counties of Bucks and Montgomery; and also, residing within the bounds of the first, second, third, fourth, fifth, sixth, (except Berks and Schuylkill counties,) seventh, ninth, eleventh, twelfth, thirteenth, fourteenth and fifteenth military divisions, who are now, or who may be enrolled hereafter in any volunteer corps of said divisions, and shall pay annually to the support of the said volunteer company, the sum of two dollars, shall be exempted from the performance of any other military duty: *Provided,* said exemption shall not continue any longer than said company is in existence, and parades agreeably to law, and the said sum of two dollars is actually paid, the evidence of which shall be the certificate of the commanding officer of the corps: *And providing also,* that all such sums shall be paid to a member of said volunteer corps, duly authorized to receive it. Volunteers exempted from military duty upon payment of \$2 annually. Proviso. 2d Proviso.
