An Act

Of divorce of David Ralston and Mary his wife, and others:

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the marriage contract by and between David Ralston, and Mary his wife, late Mary Hamilton, both of Lebanon, in the county of Lebanon, Pennsylvania, be, and the same is hereby annulled, and the parties released and discharged from said contract, as fully and effectually as if they never had been joined in marriage.
