## Resolution

Relative to the Bridge at Duncan's Island.

*Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, That the Canal Commissioners be, and they are hereby authorized and required forthwith to cause a plan and estimate to be prepared for a new towing path and traveling bridge across the Susquehanna at Duncan's Island, and to invite proposals in the usual manner, for the construction of said bridge, and to allot the said work to the person or persons whose proposals shall be most advantageous to the commonwealth: Provided, That no contract shall be made, nor the* <sup>Proviso.</sup> *commonwealth become in any manner bound to the person or persons proposing, until a specific appropriation for the construction of said bridge shall be made by law.*
