AN ACT

To amend and extend the charter of the Miners' Bank of Pottsville
in the county of Schuylkill.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the charter of the Miners' Bank of Pottsville, in the county of Schuylkill, shall be and the same hereby is extended and continued for the term of one year from the time of the expiration of the present charter, subject to all the provisions now imposed upon the said bank by the existing laws of this commonwealth, and also subject to such further provisions as the legislature may hereafter think proper to enact, for the regulation of banking institutions.

SECTION 2. The legislature hereby reserves the power to alter, revoke, or annul the charter of the said bank, whenever, in their opinion, it may be injurious to the citizens of the commonwealth; in such manner, however, that no injustice shall be done to the stockholders thereof.
