A SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An act relative to the laying out of a certain state road from Curwensville, Clearfield county, through the towns of Indiana and Saltsburg, in Indiana county, and through Westmoreland county to East Liberty, in Allegheny county, and for laying out certain other state roads, and for other purposes," passed the sixteenth day of April, Anno Domini eighteen hundred and thirty-eight.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That so much of the act passed the sixteenth day of April, Anno Domini eighteen hundred and thirty-eight, as authorizes the laying out and marking of a state road, commencing at Howell's Mills in Northampton county, and terminating at a point of the Susquehanna and Lehigh turnpike road between Beaver Meadows in Northampton county, and Conynghamtown in Luzerne county, be, and the same is hereby repealed, so far as the said road is laid out and marked from Howell's mills to Dills' ferry, within the county of Northampton.

SECTION 2. That twelve hundred dollars of the appropriation of two thousand four hundred dollars, authorized to be expended by act of fourteenth April, eighteen hundred and thirty eight, on the aforesaid road, between Howell's Mills and Stroudsburg, in Monroe county, to be expended on the state road from Easton to Milford, lying within the borders of Northampton county, and that Adam Keller and James M. Porter, be commissioners to expend the same.
