AN ACT

Making appropriations to the canals and rail roads of the commonwealth, and for other purposes.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the following sums be, and they are hereby appropriated to the purposes hereinafter mentioned, to wit:

Appropriation

To North Branch \$330,000

To the Erie extension \$250,000

\$30,000 to Sinnemahoning

\$30,000 to rail road at Columbia

\$40,000 to Wiconisco canal

\$380,000 to repay loans made to repair Juniata division

Accounts for repairs Juniata how to be settled

Pay of general Superintendent

The sum of one hundred and fifteen thousand dollars, to be applied upon work on the Tunkhannock line, North Branch division of the Pennsylvania canal. The sum of one hundred and fifteen thousand dollars, to be applied upon work on the Tioga line, North Branch division of the Pennsylvania canal; and the sum of two hundred and fifty thousand dollars, to be applied upon work on the Erie extension of the Pennsylvania canal; one hundred thousand dollars of which to be applied to the Conneaut line, and the remaining one hundred and fifty thousand to the Shenango line. The sum of thirty thousand dollars to the Sinnemahoning extension. The sum of thirty thousand dollars to the rail road to avoid the inclined plane at Columbia. The sum of forty thousand dollars to the Wiconisco canal.

The sum of three hundred and eighty thousand dollars to repay the money borrowed by the late executive of this commonwealth, for repairing the breach on the Juniata division of the Pennsylvania canal, between Huntingdon and Hollidaysburg, and defraying the balance of the expenses incurred in repairing the said breach, to be paid as soon as the account of the aforesaid expenditure shall be duly settled and approved by the Auditor General, upon vouchers properly authenticated by the disbursing officer, and shall have further been examined and approved by a joint committee of three members of the senate and three members of the house of representatives. And the Auditor General is hereby required to pass upon and settle the accounts of the general superintendent appointed by the canal commissioners, to superintend the repairs on the Juniata division, in the same manner in every respect that the accounts of other superintendants are passed and settled at his office. and should the said expendi-

ture not amount to the sum above mentioned, the balance thereof shall be considered as a part of the ordinary repair fund, and three hundred thousand dollars to be applied to the repairs on the canals and rail roads of the commonwealth, whereof fourteen thousand dollars shall be applied to repair the aqueduct at Duncan's Island, and sixteen thousand dollars shall be applied to the completion of the three locks on the Eastern division, near Duncan's Island; and the Governor is hereby authorized and required to borrow on permanent loan, the sum of one million two hundred and eighty thousand dollars, to be applied as aforesaid, at an interest not exceeding five per cent per annum, payable half yearly and to be reimbursed at any time after the first day of July, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-four, and he shall issue negotiable certificates of stock for the same transferable on the books of the Auditor General, or at the Bank of Pennsylvania, by the owner or owners of the same, and upon such transfer, new certificates shall be issued by the Auditor General and State Treasurer, or by the president and cashier of said bank, to the new holder or holders, and the interest on said stock shall be paid at the state treasury, the Bank of Pennsylvania, in Philadelphia, or elsewhere, as may be agreed upon by the Governor, and the original purchaser of the stock.
