A SUPPLEMENT

To the act passed the sixteenth day of April, Anno Domini, eighteen hundred and thirty-eight, incorporating the Orwigsburg Female Seminary, in the county of Schuylkill, and for other purposes.

Number of
trustees

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the number of trustees for the Orwigsburg Female Seminary, in the county of Schuylkill, to be elected as hereinafter provided, shall be nine, five of whom shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.

Election of

SECTION 2. That the said trustees shall be elected by the stockholders of the institution from among their number, to hold their offices until the next election, and the first election under this act shall take place on the second Saturday in February, Anno Domini, eighteen hundred and thirty-nine, and annually thereafter on the first Saturday in February. The place of election shall be at the seminary, and under such notice and regulations as shall be adopted by the stockholders. *Provided,* That any irregularity in holding the said elections or failure to elect officers, shall in no case dissolve the corporation; but on failure to elect officers, at the time and place aforesaid, and according to law, they may be elected at another time in the mode provided by a majority of the stockholders of the institution.

Act of trustees
validated

SECTION 3. That the organization of the said seminary by Charles Fraily, William B. Potts, Jacob Hammar and John Bannan, the trustees named in the act to which this is a supplement, and all their acts as trustees of the said seminary from their organization thereof according to the provisions of the act to which this is a supplement, until the election of trustees, as provided in this act, shall be considered as effectual for the organization and government of the said seminary, and be regarded as of the same validity as though the same had been organized and governed by a quorum of five or more trustees.
