AN ACT

Providing for the holding of township elections in the township of Branch, in the county of Schuylkill.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That from and after the passage of this act, the qualified electors of Branch township, in the county of Schuylkill; shall hold their township elections at the public house now occupied by the widow Christ, in the borough of Minersville, in said township, and until otherwise directed by the provisions of the first section of the act of the thirteenth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and seven.
