## A SUPPLEMENT.

To an act entitled "An act to incorporate the Wyoming Coal Company."

**SECTION 1.** *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the Wyoming coal company, incorporated in pursuance of an act of the general assembly, passed the sixteenth day of April, eighteen hundred and thirty-eight, be and they are hereby authorized to hold lands in Newport township, in the county of Luzerne, as fully as if the said township of Newport, had been embraced in the act to which this is a supplement, and that the said company be and they are hereby authorized to hold within the said township of Newport, and in the other townships mentioned in the act, to which this is a supplement, the additional quantity of one thousand acres of land, for the purpose of carrying on their operations, and that they be authorized to increase their capital stock, the sum of one hundred thousand dollars, for constructing railways from their lands, situate within the townships of Pittston, Wilkesbarre, Hanover and Newport to intersect the North Branch canal, or other improvements leading thereto, at such points as they may deem most convenient. The united length of the said rail roads shall not be less than ten miles, five miles of which shall be completed within five years, and the remainder within ten years from the passage of this act, otherwise the said company shall forfeit the benefits, rights, privileges and powers hereby granted. *Provided,* That it shall be lawful for the legislature at any time to amend or repeal any of the foregoing provisions, and to rescind the powers hereby granted, and this provision shall extend as well to the original charter as to this supplement, but in such manner however, that no injustice shall be done to the corporators.
