A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To an act entitled "An act incorporating the Lyken's Valley Rail Road Company, in Dauphin County," passed on the seventh day of April, in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That it shall be lawful for the stockholders of the Lykens Valley rail road and coal company, at any meeting summoned by the managers thereof, to authorize the president and managers to increase the capital stock of said company to any amount not exceeding in the whole the sum of four hundred thousand dollars, whereupon the said president and managers may increase the said capital stock accordingly, and sell and dispose of the new stock at their discretion, and issue certificates therefor in the usual form.

May increase the capital stock
Not to exceed \$400,000

SECTION 2. It shall be lawful for the president and managers of the said company, from time to time, and at all times, to borrow such sums of money, and on such terms as they may deem expedient, for the use of said company, and to issue certificates of loan therefor, and to pledge and mortgage all or any part of the estates, tolls, rail road improvements, privileges, effects and assets whatsoever, of the said company for the re-payment of said sums of money so borrowed at such times as may be agreed on, and for the punctual payment of interest for the same.
