AN ACT

For the relief of William Lyon and others, soldiers and widows of soldiers of the Revolutionary and Indian wars.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same. That the state treasurer be and he is hereby authorized and required to pay to William Lyon, of Venango county, Peter Palmer, of Indiana county, David Shields, of Armstrong county, Abraham Fryer, William Colmer, William Wilson, of Butler county, William Nichols, of Fayette county, William Walton, of Luzerne county, and John George Hummel, of Northumberland county, soldiers, and Catharine E. Wolf, of Lehigh county, Salome Meyers, of Northampton county, Magdalena Hoffman, of Lancaster county, Mary Smith, of Monroe county, widows of soldiers of revolutionary and Indian wars, or to their respective orders. forty dollars immediately, as a gratuity and an annuity of forty dollars each during life, payable half yearly, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-nine.

SECTION 2. That the state treasurer be and he is hereby authorized and required to pay to James Campbell of Westmoreland county, or to his order, a gratuity of forty dollars in full for his military services; the foregoing gratuity and annuities to be paid in conformity to the existing laws.
