A SUPPLEMENT

To an act entitled "An act to authorize the Governor to incorporate a company, for making a turnpike road from the Belmont and Easton turnpike road, at or near the road to Edmond Harford's mill, through Newfoundland, to the Belmont and Easton turnpike, near the line of Wayne and Pike counties.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same.* That the time allowed in and by the act for the incorporation of the president, managers and company of the Sterling and Newfoundland turnpike road, approved the tenth day of April, Anno Domini, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-five, for the completion of the said road, be, and the same is hereby extended three years from the tenth day of April, Anno Domini, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-nine. And the said corporation is hereby renewed, with all the rights and privileges conferred by the said act, as fully as if the said road had been completed within the time therein limited.
