A SUPPLEMENT

To the act entitled "An act to incorporate the summit Coal company," passed the eighteenth day of March, Anno Domini, eighteen hundred and thirty-six.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the Summit coal company may apply any portion of the one hundred thousand dollars, capital stock which they are authorized to create for the purpose of constructing a rail road which may remain unexpended after the completion of said road in making tunnels, drifts, inclined planes, and other fixtures and improvements necessary or convenient in carrying on the operations of said company. And that the time in which the said company is required to complete their road is hereby extended to the first of September next.
