A SUPPLEMENT

To an act entitled "An act authorizing the Governor to incorporate the Lackawanna and Susquehanna Rail Road company," passed the eleventh day of March, Anno Domini, eighteen hundred and twenty-six.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That so much of the original act to which this is a supplement, as regulates the use of said rail road, be, and the same is hereby repealed.

Part of the original act repealed

SECTION 2. That the annual elections prescribed by said act shall hereafter be held on the third Tuesday of January, in each and every year, and that all previous irregularities and omissions, relative to the annual elections, shall not impair the charter of said company, or invalidate its acts.

Time of holding annual elections, &c.

When tolls may be charged

SECTION 3. That on the completion of any section of two miles, on the main line of said rail road, or any lateral road connected, or to be connected with it, the rates of toll as established by the twentieth section of said act, may be charged and collected.

Lateral rail-road authorized

Money may be borrowed

SECTION 4. That the president and managers of said rail road, be authorized to make a lateral rail road from some convenient point on the main line of said rail road, to the river Lackawaxen near the narrows thereof and that the said president and managers be authorized from time to time to borrow money for the purposes of the company, for such periods of time and on such terms for the security and repayment thereof as they may deem proper or necessary.
